

**PER ORDER OF THE BOARD OF SELECTMEN  
TOWN ROAD WEIGHT LIMIT ORDINANCE**

Pursuant to State of NH RSA 231:191, the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Freedom, New Hampshire authorizes the Freedom Road Agent to restrict the weight of trucks traveling over roads within the Town of Freedom. The year round gross vehicle weight limit for through trucking on Ossipee Lake Road and Bennett Road shall be 12 tons. The seasonal limit on all Town roads shall be 6 tons gross vehicle weight. Such restrictions may be placed on any road within the Town of Freedom, whether State or local, when, at the discretion of the Freedom Road Agent, said roads may be unreasonably damaged or cause extra ordinary Town maintenance expense from passage of vehicles. Such notification signage shall contain the phrase "Subject to fines up to \$1,000.00 for individuals and up to \$20,000.00 for all other persons, plus damages."

Further pursuant to State of NH RSA 231:191 the Town of Freedom reserves the right to fine violators of this Town of Freedom Ordinance at the arresting officer's discretion, an amount in the following schedule for individuals:

First offense: A warning or \$250.00 fine plus damages

Second offense: \$1,000.00 fine plus damages

And for all other persons:

First offense: A warning or \$500.00 fine plus damages


Second offense: \$5000.00 fine plus damages

The Town of Freedom, pursuant to State of NH RSA 231:191, reserves the right to recover actual road damages and legal expenses related thereto, in addition to the aforementioned fines.

Violators of this Ordinance shall be cited by the Freedom Police Department's arresting officer or any police officer by marking the NH Violation Summons "Violation of Town of Freedom Road Weight Limit Ordinance, and shall direct the payment of the appropriate fine to "Treasurer, Town of Freedom" at the address identified at the bottom of the NH Violation Summons or by Summons to the Southern Carroll County District Court.
